

Chairman's Report – January 2018

Well that's another year gone and although the year started slowly and we had to suffer still more legislation I was concerned that we were on track for another year with no profit but thankfully because of the due diligence and hard work from all the staff and of course you the members and users of the Club you have managed to turn a £27k deficit into just over a £10k surplus which is no mean feat in this day and age.

We continue to promote the Club for ex-service and community use and the place is widely used by many organisations and groups. The ex-service Breakfast Club which meets the first Sunday of every month at 11.00am is still going strong thanks to Chris Collins. The Men's Shed should have phase one up and working around mid February and the River Dee Radio is still going strong. We also now run a book sale on the first Saturday of every month which was inherited from the Lions Club when they disbanded and alongside that we run a car boot sale from April to September.

The committee continue to do a great job and have my sincere thanks for all the hard work they put in. I would also like to give a special thank you to all who helped with the poppy collection period. This year we collected £10,000, down £1,000 from last year but according to Poppy Scotland that looks to be the trend all over Scotland. Our thanks also to the Pipe Band for the excellent work they continue to do to help us celebrate and remember events. That said the last four years have been extremely busy with commemoration and remembrance events but 2018 is going to be the busiest of all.
